Dates & Tuition

The Champions Spring Break Baseball Camp will be held on March 9th-12th, Monday—Thursday. Camp hours on Monday—Wednesday are 8:30 a.m.—4 p.m. Camp ends at 12:30 p.m. on Thursday. Drop off will begin at 7:30 a.m. to help with work schedules.

The tuition of camp is \$195.00 which includes deposit, a Baseball Camp t-shirt, and an evaluation. The deposit is non-refundable. There will be a \$10.00 discount if registration is received prior to the first day of camp.

Check-In Procedure

On the first day of camp, registration is from 7:30 a.m.—8:30 a.m. Check in will take place on the Millsaps Baseball Field unless weather forces us into the gym.
